- 4. Denying, the LCP Investor Claims set forth in **Exhibit A-4** attached to Petition No. 110;
- 5. Denying the General Creditor Claims set forth in **Exhibit A-5** attached to Petition No. 110;
- 6. Approving the Unsecured Claim Amounts of the Warehouse Lenders Claims as set forth in **Exhibit B** attached to Petition No. 110;
- 7. Declaring that all claims set forth in <u>Exhibits A-1</u> through <u>A-5</u> and in <u>Exhibit</u>

 <u>B</u> attached to Petition No. 110, are subordinate to the amounts owed to DFI for reimbursement under A.R.S. §6-131.01(B);
- 8. Authorizing the Receiver to abandon any interests held by the Receiver arising out of the loans set forth in **Exhibit D-2** attached to Petition No. 110;
- 9. Authorizing the Receiver to transfer all remaining assets of the receivership estate to DFI as partial reimbursement of the expenses incurred by DFI, including but not limited to the loans set forth in **Exhibit D-1** attached to Petition No. 110;
- 10. Authorizing the Deputy Receiver, Thomas J. Giallanza, to execute all documents necessary to effectuate the relief granted by the Court herein; and

11. Directing the Receiver to file with the Court a petition setting forth the plan for the prompt termination of this receivership.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Pursuant to Rule 54(b), Ariz.R.Civ.P., the Court makes the express determination that there is no just reason for delay and makes the express determination directing entry of this Order at this time as a final judgment.
